Dear Parent/Carer,

As the colder weather sets in, we are keen to re-introduce hot lunches into the school and following discussions with Cater Link Ltd, I am now pleased to confirm the trial of staggered hot lunch provision from w/b 03.11.2020, while following COVID protocols and ensuring health and safety for all in school.

With staggered lunches each year group will be allocated a day on which they have the option of having a hot lunch instead of a packed lunch. Those year groups not scheduled for a hot lunch that day, will continue to have the packed lunch option as they have been doing up until now.

The food will be packed into individual re-usable containers. Containers along with a list of children who have selected a hot lunch will be distributed by staff in accordance to the orders placed and eaten in the classroom. It is very important that your child remembers to order their lunch in class during morning registration.

At present, we can only offer a vegetarian option. This allows Cater Link the time to manage both hot and cold lunch provisions on a daily basis. As we move through the half term we will regularly review the hot meal provision. We have always intended to return to hot meals while maintaining the day-to-day running of the school in a COVID secure manner.
