# New Knowledge

- Know the purpose of a sketchbook and how to use it to develop ideas and experiments with designs.
- Know the work of some artists, craftspeople, architects and designers, and use their work as an inspiration for own ideas
- I know how to make my own elastic band sketchbook
- I know that using certain techniques, I can achieve effects like texturing, layering, pattern and lines
- I know what the colour wheel shows and how I can use that to help me find contrasting colours.

### New Skills


