- Concept Links/Prior Knowledge- Hinduism**
- What can we learn from the Diwali story about good and evil in our own lives?
 - To know some of the ways in which Christmas is celebrated in different ways by different Christians
 - To know how stories in Hinduism are inspirational for believers (Diwali story)
 - To remember and talk about the Diwali story
 - To understand the importance of different symbols and figures in the Diwali story (Divas, Aum, Rangolis, Ram and Sita)
 - To know how this story teaches about good and evil.

Sticky learning

New Knowledge

To know key features of an inspirational event, place, ritual or special occasion

To know what a "Home" is and what makes their home special.

Know who might live in a home and identify who lives in their home.

To know what kind of things happen in a home. Eating/Sleeping/entertaining /prayer/meditation

To know that some faiths use their homes for praying and create a special place for this.

To know a Puja ceremony is and involves. (Hindu daily prayer).

To know the importance and role of food in our homes and how in Hinduism offerings are made to god (prashad)

To know some of the objects used during a puja ceremony.

To know what is the Namaskara Sutra? (Jain daily prayer)

N.B Jains believe that the Gods and Idols are representations of the different aspects of humanity. All of which we have. The Gods themselves are not "real"

New Skills

I can talk about what is important to me and to other people with respect for feelings

Recognise art, symbols and words featured in religions and other belief systems, and talk about them with reference to the Puja ceremony for Hinduism.



Hinduism symbol- om




Hindu puja ceremony


