## Me in my World

### Knowledge

- Say one number for each item in order: 1,2,3,4,5.
- Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total ('cardinal principle').
- Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'.
- Select shapes appropriately: flat surfaces for building, a triangular prism for a roof etc.
- Understand the key concepts about print: print has meaning and print can have different purposes
- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary
- Explore different materials freely, in order to develop their ideas about how to use them and what to make.
- Recognise their name and make marks to represent it. Writes some letters in their name.
- Listen attentively in a range of situations
- Take part in pretend play, communicating and negotiating with their friends.
- Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting (happy to talk to the different adult in the unit).
- Talk about their feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry' or 'worried'.

### Key Questions

- What makes a kind friend?
- Who is in your family?
- How are you feeling?
- What makes you feel happy, sad, angry, worried?
- How are these groups the same/different?
- What do you notice about the weather today?
