British Museum

Visit room 69 and explore the daily life of both the ancient Greeks and Romans. The cases are displayed in themes covering the major aspects of everyday life, some of the cases display both Greek and Roman objects. Cases in the centre of the room concentrate on everyday life, whereas the cases along one wall display crafts and on the other mythology.

On the balcony/upper level, you will discover examples of terracotta, lamps and glass vessels. The north exit leads into a suite of galleries exploring the ancient Greek and Roman worlds. The south-eastern exit leads into the Money Gallery.

Tate Modern

See some of the world's most exciting modern and contemporary art at Tate Modern. Enjoy innovative works that have shaped art as we know it. The gallery is free to visit. On display are paintings, sculptures and large-scale installations from artists around the world including Pablo Picasso, Yayoi Kusama and Henri Matisse. Explore the iconic Turbine Hall alongside the underground Tanks, a striking space dedicated to live performances and video.
