

# Year 1 – Knowledge Organiser - PLACE VALUE TO 20

## Key Learning:

- Count variety of objects using 1:1 correspondence
- Represent numbers using different representations
- Read and write numbers up to 20
- Count forwards and backwards from any given number to 20
- Count 1 more / Count 1 less - Identify teen numbers
- Compare groups using the language fewer, more, less, greater than, less than, equal
- Order numbers
- Use the symbols  $<$   $>$   $=$  for comparing
- Identify numbers that fall between two given numbers
- Partition numbers up to 20 into tens and ones
- Match numerals and words
- Use ordinal vocabulary such as 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc.

### Key Vocabulary

<b>Count</b>	Saying numbers in a certain order
<b>Compare</b>	Examining the difference between two numbers
<b>Digit</b>	A single whole number within a two or more digit number
<b>Less</b>	Smaller than
<b>More</b>	Greater than
<b>Numeral</b>	A symbol or name that represents a number
<b>Order</b>	Putting things in the correct place following a rule
<b>Place value</b>	The value of each digit within a number
<b>Teen number</b>	A number between 10 and 20.

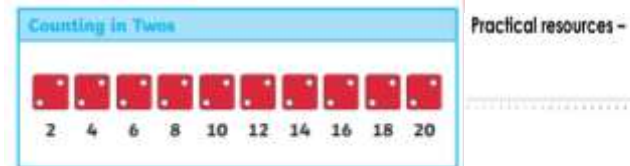
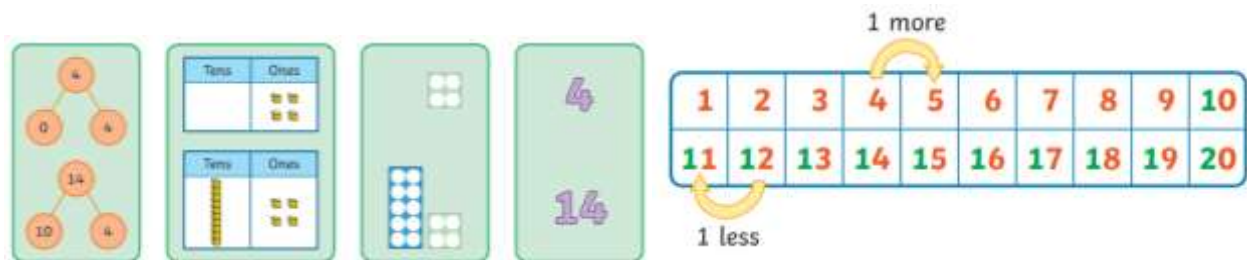
### Comparing groups and numbers -
