#### RE



Most religions have a set of rules, commandments or expectations of their followers. Can you make a list of rules or expectations that are important to you? For example, we should treat others how we would like to be treated. You could display this information on a word document, a poster or another creative way!

#### Science



In science, we are exploring different ways of measuring time. Can you conduct an experiment that explores how your shadow changes over time? Stand in the same sunny spot, and get an adult to help you measure your shadow early morning, Lunchtime, and in the evening? What conclusions can you draw.

#### History



The Mayans and the Aztecs were both ancient civilizations that originated in the America and Mexico. Can you create a Venn diagram to explain similarities and differences in their cultures and beliefs?

#### Art



Gather some natural resources, these may include leaves, grass, sticks. Can you manipulate these materials to create an image of your choice? Perhaps a still image, a landscape or even self-portrait!

#### English



In the style of a newspaper article, write about something exciting you have done this half term. For example, a trip to the zoo may have the headline: Breaking News; Mrs Murphy, Meets Monkeys! Try to include the features of a newspaper, this includes, headline, journalist's name, key facts, 5 w's.

#### French



Create a word search using a French topic, for example, animals, fruit and vegetables, or colours. See if you can get a friend or family member to find all the words!
